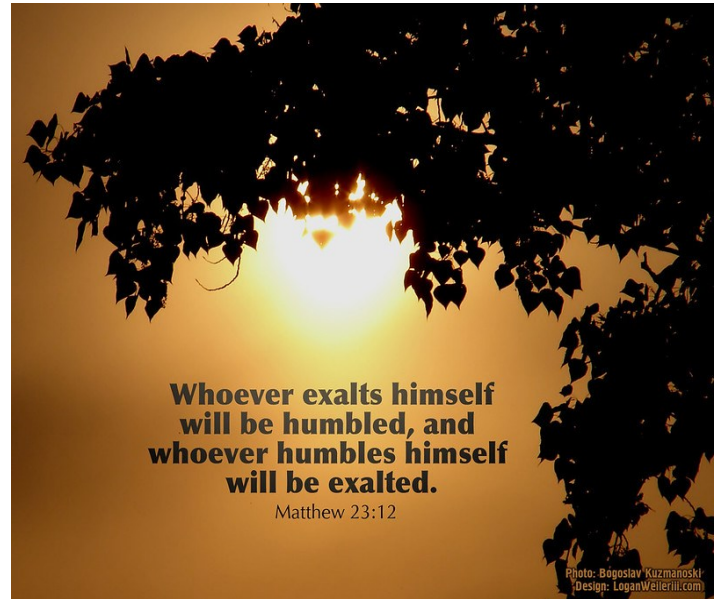

## Sunday Reflection

### The Call to Humility

A compliment heard about another can draw various reactions. If we are envious, we may want to correct what seems the naïve impression; if we are admirers, we may add our own praise. I remember hearing a priest give high tribute to his first pastor. Some in the gathering raised their eyebrows or scoffed; another man, by contrast, told a wonderful story of this same pastor daily visiting a terminally ill mother with young children during her last month of life, always bringing chocolate or cookies for the children.

Jesus on occasion spoke words of praise for an individual, but none so strongly expressed as these: Among those born of women, there has been none grater than John the Baptist. He is the last of the prophets and a bridge between the Old and New Testaments, and he has a dramatic role in announcing the imminent coming of Jesus as the Messiah. But we might ask what quality in John Jesus saw as most worthy of divine admiration. What words of John can provoke our own deeper desire to do something beautiful for God?

Saint John's single phrase *He Must increase, I must decrease* may answer well these questions. The great spiritual need to give way to God and become less ourselves, embracing a long for humility, will always attract God to our soul.

*Father Almighty, may we learn from St. John the Baptist to be humble, that your Son may fill us with his presence and we may be his servants in all things.*
