

Sunday Reflection

Jesus' parable is about two children, a father needed help in his vineyard. When he sent his children, one of them committed the unthinkable offense of openly defying the father. The second child responded with great formal respect but did nothing to satisfy the father's need.

Obviously, neither child acted rightly. One defied the father, the other replied politely and then rendered the words meaningless. Then Jesus says that the disrespectful child had a "change of mind." This change of mind implied a refocusing of values.

Today's reading presents a relatable scenario of promises made and broken, highlighting that genuine faith is demonstrated through obedience. It calls us to identify honestly with one of the children and then to really listen to the other. The Gospel is always a call for a change of heart and mind that opens us up to other perspectives—including God's own. Jesus' obedience, even unto death, urges listeners to mirror His faithful heart encouraging a life where actions align with professed beliefs.
